

MARY JO YOUNG DUAL CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP



Model Lab High School Dual Credit

Kentucky high school juniors and seniors have until May 15 to apply for a scholarship to help pay for dual credit classes taken at a Kentucky college or university. The Mary Jo Young Scholarship, named for a former member of the Board of Directors of the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority (KHEAA), provides assistance with tuition and textbook expenses for up to two classes each semester. Scholarships can only be used in the fall and spring semesters.

To be considered, students must be in grades 11 or 12 during the 2017-2018 academic year. They must have at least an 18 ACT composite or earn at least a 2.5 GPA during the 2016-2017 academic year. Priority is given to students eligible for free and reduced-price lunch. The application is available on www.kheaa.com. Students must apply through their www.kheaa.com account.

KHEAA is the state agency that administers the Kentucky Educational Excellence Scholarship (KEES), need-based grants and other programs to help students pay their higher education expenses. MARY JO YOUNG SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- **Student must:**
 - Be enrolled in dual credit courses at a Kentucky college.
 - Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
 - Be a legal resident of Kentucky.
 - Be a high school junior or senior during the 2017-2018 academic year.
 - Either have an ACT composite score of 18 or higher; OR achieve a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher for the 2016-2017 academic year.
- **Award:**
 - Up to \$420 for one course or \$840 for two courses.
 - Reimbursement of textbook cost up to \$125 for one course or \$250 for two courses.
- **Application:**
 - The application deadline for the 2016-2017 year is May 15, 2017.
