EKU MANCHESTER IS THRILLED TO OFFER YOU THE NEW STATE REGISTERED NURSE AIDE (SRNA/CNA) TRAINING PROGRAM! Nurse aides are a vital part to any hospital or long-term care facility. Jobs are available close to home, and career growth is attainable! To become an SRNA in Kentucky, you must attend at least 75 hours (59 hours of classroom time and 16 hours of clinical experience) of approved nurse aide instruction. EKU Manchester has a class scheduled to offer just that! Cohort #2 begins on October 7th and allows students to complete the course in just a few short weeks with evening class hours before testing for state certification. Act fast! Class size is limited to 15 students per cohort on a first-come, first served basis!

^R Students are required to have a minimum of 59 Classroom hours. Students who miss more than two (2) of the above Class (15), Make-up (1) and/or Practice (1) Dates will not be permitted to test at the end of the program. There are also two (2) mandatory Clinical dates.

Prior to beginning the SRNA program*, each participant will be required to provide the following:

1. Immunization Record (MMR, TDaP, Varicella, Hep B & Influenza vaccines are required).
Note: Documentation must include: Student's name, DOB, Dates shots were administered and Name of the healthcare provider OR UHS compliance form OR Employee compliance form OR State immunization certificate or registry.
2. Social Security Card (cannot be laminated).
3. Picture Identification Card (i.e. Driver's License) where full name directly matches name on Social Security Card.

Students must turn in items 1-3 at EKU Manchester. After submitting the above items, EKU will complete background checks from the Kentucky Nurse Aide Registry, the DCBS Misconduct Registry, and a Nation-wide background check. After we have received cleared background checks, you will be contacted by Edwina Blevins with an appointment time to complete steps 4 & 5 below.

Participants will be required to:

4. Pass a drug test administered by Landmark of Laurel Creek.
5. Take a two-step TB skin test administered by Landmark of Laurel Creek.

Tuition will be due when steps 1-5 have been completed.

Participants are responsible for the cost of:

- Tuition - \$600 (includes the cost of malpractice insurance, drug screening, TB skin test and background check)
- Program Textbook - \$65 (must be paid prior to attending Orientation)
- Scrubs (any color excluding navy blue)
- Non-Skid Shoes
- Watch with a Second Hand
- State Test Registration Fee - \$75 (payable to KCTCS Pineville)

***The program will be limited to the first 15 students who complete the application process (Steps 1-5) and pay the tuition.**
