



SPRING 2019 EKU MANCHESTER DUAL CREDIT SCHEDULE (AS 12/5/18)



QUALIFYING HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS AND SENIORS MAY QUALIFY FOR
UP TO 8 FREE CLASSES AT EKU (2 COURSES PER SEMESTER*, FALL AND SPRING)

*Students may choose to enroll in one summer course. If you choose to enroll in a Summer course, the Summer course will count towards your total course allowance (maximum - 8 total/2 per fall and spring semesters). For example:

If a rising senior has accumulated 4 courses and takes a Summer course, that student will be permitted to enroll in 3 additional courses for Fall 2018/Spring 2019 (maximum 2 per semester). Tuition for Summer will be \$53 per credit hour. Eku Dual Credit scholarships and KHEAA scholarships cannot be applied to Summer term courses.

How to Apply

1. Apply online at www.dualcredit.edu
2. Sign the Tuition Acknowledgement Form
3. Submit Transcript
4. Submit any test scores not on transcript.
5. Attend Orientation (Dec 12 or Jan 3 at 3:30 pm)

EKU Now! Dual Credit Scholarship - One (1) Dual Credit class free per semester (Fall/Spring)

You must have a 3.0 high school GPA or higher.

You must have minimum ACT/PLAN scores of 18 in English, 19 in Math, 20 in Reading and a 21 Composite.

Whitlock Scholar Candidate - Two (2) Dual Credit classes free per semester (Fall/Spring)

A minimum un-weighted 3.5 high school GPA.

Minimum ACT scores of 18 in Eng, 19 in Math, 20 in Reading and a 23 Comp. (PLAN scores are not considered for this scholarship).

Students with a 3.0 GPA and min. ACT/PLAN of 18 Eng, 20 Reading and 20 Composite qualify for the Dual Credit tuition (Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 is \$53 per credit hour-\$159 for a 3 credit-hour course).

Students are responsible for the full cost of textbooks, parking permits, associated course fees and late registration fees if applicable.

Spring 2019 Eku Manchester Dual Credit Schedule (Ask about other Gen. Ed. OR CRJ/PLS classes that might be offered at your school)

EKU Now! students can register for credit classes that fulfill general education requirements (www.gened.edu). Class availability will vary according to semester and location. EKU Now! students must meet both EKU Now! requirements and the usual course prerequisites including any additional ACT requirements. **To be considered for a limited number of online classes, students must email dualcredit@eku.edu. Participation in online classes is subject to availability.**

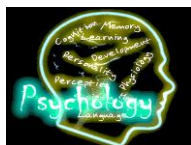
